Canada Post Heritage Club - Golden Sheaf Chapter

A social club comprised of long service and retired employees of Canada Post Corporation. Members participate in rewarding social and community events, including fundraising activities.

CARP - Regina Chapter

CARP is a not-for-profit, non-partisan organization, with over 320,000 members throughout Canada. Our chapter advocates for older adults to live in dignity and free from ageism, regardless of health, family or financial circumstances.

Saskatchewan Retirees Association (SRA)

A volunteer led, non-profit organization of current and retired Saskatchewan provincial public sector employees, working together to support the interests and wellbeing of the lives of our members.

Saskatchewan Seniors Association Incorporated

Working to bring seniors together in one strong, non-partisan, non-racial, non-sectarian organization that will work for the welfare of all seniors in Saskatchewan.

Saskatchewan Senior Fitness Association (SSFA)

A volunteer, non-government organization formed in response to the need for an activity program for people fifty years of age and older. The main objective of the association is to promote active living, wellness and participation.

Saskatchewan Union Retirees Federation (SURF)

A provincial lobby group representing retired public, private, or trade union members. It is affiliated with the Congress of Union Retirees of Canada (CURC). CURC and SURF were established to lobby all levels of government for improvements on issues affecting retirees.

Saskatoon Services for Seniors

A not-for-profit, charitable organization dedicated to providing services that enable older adults (55+), seniors and physically challenged individuals to reside independently in their own homes for as long as possible.

Saskatoon Council on Aging (SCOA)

A community based organization dedicated to promoting positive aging for all members of our community. They strive to achieve their mission by providing programs and services to promote dignity, health and independence of older adults.
